

THE SOUTH DERBYSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTIONS TO VARIOUS STREETS
IN HILTON) ORDER 2022

MADE UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847

WHEREAS between the hours of 6:00am and 10:00pm on Friday 3rd June Two Thousand and Twenty-two, certain streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed, the SOUTH DERBYSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, do HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said streets referred to below on the said day between the said hours, the following regulations shall be observed:-

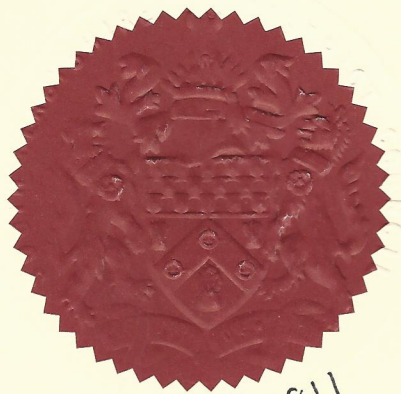
1. Main Street, Hilton, Derbyshire between the junctions with Sutton Lane and Dale End Road including the junction with Back Lane for a distance of 100 meters from the junction with Main Street, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including motor and pedal cycles during the dates and times shown above.

2. Drivers of vehicles proceeding to these roads will be diverted in both directions from Derby Road, along Egginton Road then following The Mease to Uttoxeter Road.
 - Access to Sutton Lane and Dale End Road is maintained.
 - Access to Back Lane (and adjoining roads) from Egginton Road / Peacroft Lane


The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Any person who offends against any of the provisions contained in this Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Thousand pounds.
